

Evergreen Trees



As the name suggests, evergreen trees are in leaf year-round. New leaves push out the old as the tree grows, so unless the tree is under stress, the foliage is always present. Some trees are classified as 'semi-evergreen' meaning that if the tree gets too cold or too dry, they will drop most or all of their leaves in order to conserve energy and protect the overall tree from death. Evergreen trees do not usually have showy flowers or vibrant autumnal coloration but provide an excellent monochromatic background for deciduous trees and smaller plantings.
