

Flowering Trees



Blossom trees can transform a garden each spring into a delightful showcase of colour and fragrance. Some flowering trees are covered with blooms for 2-4 weeks, while others offer a more limited display, some flower early before putting out leaves, while others bud and bloom at the end of spring, and still other trees put out flowers that are hardly noticeable, being purely for reproduction.
