Trees that produce edible fruit and nuts, such as plum, cherry, apple, pear, walnut, olive, etc. offer the double attraction of spring flowers followed by autumn harvest. A further attraction is their VAT-exempt status, making them a beautiful and economical garden tree. When selecting a fruit and nut bearing tree, please be aware that some, like the walnut tree, will not fruit or nut until fully mature and most will require a pollination partner in the vicinity. The pollination partner will need to flower at the same time and, since most pollination is done by bees, the closer the partner is geographically the more they will fruit.

We grow a wide range of semi-mature fruit and nut trees either as half-standard, low standard (1.5 - 1.8m or 5-6' trunks), full standard and a limited range of pleached fruit trees.

Ficus carica (Fig) is an evocative addition to a warm sunny corner.



The old fashioned **Medlar** (*Mespilus germanica*) is an ideal choice for a period home or cottage garden planting.

- d) if you require advice on tree selection, please email photographs of the area to be planted as well as a general overview of the site together with information on soil type if known, what you hope to achieve and any budgetary restrictions. We will then recommend appropriate trees.
