Few trees are truly 'small.' In the industry a small tree is classified as under 30' (10m) tall. Keep in mind, however, that even most medium-sized trees can be managed by pruning to acceptable heights. There are a few trees, particularly shrubs varieties that have been trained into tree forms, that never get any taller than 15-20' (5-7m). This tree selection list includes all our small trees as well as medium sized trees that can be managed by pruning. We have not included any trees whose vigorous growth habit would make them difficult to maintain at acceptable heights.
