

# Screening Trees

Trees that block, hide or give privacy are usually called screening trees. They are often evergreen, but can be deciduous. Not limited to conifers and hedging, screening may also take the form of pleached trees to form an aerial hedge or densely branching standards which allow design scope for underplanting with shrubs and perennials. Our list includes all these options, but please contact us for further advice as required.
